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## BYLAWS FOR THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE OF NAVAJYOTHI COLLEGE

# **Article I: Establishment and Purpose**

- 1. **Establishment:** A Discipline Committee is hereby established to maintain discipline, uphold the college's code of conduct, and ensure a conducive learning environment.
- 2. **Purpose:** 
  - o To investigate allegations of misconduct by students.
  - o To adjudicate cases of misconduct and impose appropriate penalties.
  - To promote a positive and respectful college culture.
  - o To deter future misconduct.

# **Article II: Composition**

- 1. **Membership:** The Discipline Committee shall consist of the following members:
  - o Principal (Chairperson)
  - o Vice Principal (Academic)
  - o Vice Principal (Administration)
  - o Two faculty members (nominated by the Principal)
  - o One student representative (elected by the Student Council)
- 2. **Term:** The members of the committee shall serve a term of one academic year.
- 3. **Quorum:** A majority of the committee members shall constitute a quorum.

#### **Article III: Powers and Duties**

#### 1. Powers:

- o To investigate complaints of misconduct.
- o To summon witnesses and examine evidence.
- To impose disciplinary actions, including but not limited to:
  - Warning
  - Fine
  - Suspension
  - Expulsion

# 2. **Duties:**

- o To review and update the college's code of conduct.
- o To educate students about the code of conduct and disciplinary procedures.
- o To maintain records of disciplinary actions.
- o To submit annual reports to the Principal.

### **Article IV: Procedures**

- 1. **Complaint Filing:** Complaints against students shall be filed in writing to the Principal or the Discipline Committee Chairperson.
- 2. **Investigation:** The committee shall conduct a thorough investigation of the complaint, including interviewing witnesses and collecting evidence.
- 3. **Hearing:** A hearing shall be conducted to allow the accused student to present their defense.
- 4. **Decision-Making:** The committee shall make a decision based on the evidence presented and the applicable rules and regulations.
- 5. **Appeal:** The accused student may appeal the decision of the committee to the Principal.

## **Article V: Amendments**

These bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds majority vote of the Discipline Committee, subject to the approval of the Principal.
