



Bylaws of the FLORA - Nature Club

Article I: Name and Purpose

1.1 Name: The official name of the organization shall be the FLORA - Nature Club.

1.2 Purpose: The primary purpose of the FLORA - Nature Club is to:

Promote environmental awareness and conservation.

Foster a love for nature and natural sciences.

Encourage students to engage in hands-on environmental projects.

Educate students about biodiversity and ecosystems.

Inspire students to become responsible environmental citizens.

Article II: Membership

2.1 Eligibility:

All students of the college are eligible to be members of the FLORA - Nature Club.

Article III: Organization

3.1 Executive Committee:
The Executive Committee shall consist of:
President
Vice President
Secretary
Treasurer
Environment Officer
Social Media Officer
3.2 Term of Office:
The term of office of the Executive Committee shall be one year (calendar year).
3.3 Powers and Responsibilities of the Executive Committee:
Manage all affairs of the Association.
Incur and meet necessary expenses.
Enlist members.
Hold regular Committee meetings.
Periodically review records and accounts.
Scrutinize annual reports, audited accounts, and proposed budgets.
Implement decisions of the General Body.
Propose amendments to the Bylaws.

Article IV: Activities

4.1 Regular Activities:

Nature Walks and Field Trips: Organize nature walks and field trips to local parks, forests, and natural areas.

Plantation Drives: Conduct tree plantation drives and maintain campus greenery.

Wildlife Conservation: Organize awareness campaigns and fundraisers for wildlife conservation.

Environmental Education Workshops: Conduct workshops on topics like climate change, biodiversity, and sustainable living.

Community Outreach: Collaborate with local organizations to organize community cleanup drives and environmental education programs.

Scientific Research: Encourage students to conduct research projects on environmental topics.
