Executive Members: 2 Representatives from staff

Members: Students' Representatives from Departments/ Union.

STUDENTS ACTIVITY

- ✓ The Fine Arts Club of the college has to oversee the training and conducting of the art competition in the college.
- ✓ The Fine Arts committee shall select appropriate persons to participate in the art competition conducted at University.
- ✓ They shall also conduct arts competitions at the college in the academic year.
- ✓ The competition items shall be declared in advance for the preparation.

Apart from the conduct of competitions, the committee should compulsorily conduct the following programmes in the college;

- ✓ A minimum of three programmes on various themes shall be conducted in an academic year
- ✓ Provide short term training for street play, dance, and other items that can correlate to the social issues of the time.
- ✓ Conduct periodical exhibitions on social awareness programmes as extension programmes.

Documentation

- ✓ The Club members should keep the minute's book of every meeting without fail.
- ✓ The report shall be submitted at the meeting for approval.
- ✓ There should be a report on each programme with adequate photos and other documents.
- ✓ A yearly report should be prepared by the end of the academic year, preferably in March.
- ✓ All the reports shall be submitted to the principal for verification and approval.
