The Fourth Estate Media Workshop, organized by the PG Department of English, Navajyothi College in association with INKJOURN literary club along with Government College Peringome, on 16/03/24- 17/03/24. It provided participants with valuable insights into the world of media, focusing on the fields of print media and broadcast journalism. The workshop spanned across two days and attracted the participation of 32 students. The seminar sessions were delivered by three distinguished resource persons who brought their expertise and experience from the media industry. They are Mr. Ghees Peter - Subeditor of 24 News Channel, Mr. Kishore Thomas - Journalist in 24 News Channel and Ms. Anjali Raj AV – Sub editor in Brave India News.

The media workshop started on 16th Mrach at 10 am at Navajyothi college, Cherupuzha. Programme was inaugurated by Fr. John Kochupurackal (Manager, Navajyothi college). The presidential address was delivered by Dr. Navya V K (HoD, Department of English, Govt. college Peringome). Welcome speech by Fr. Sijoy Paul (Director, Navajyothi college). Fr. Jythois Sebastian (Bursar, Navajyothi college) and college chairman Mr. Muhammed Minhaj P S gave felicitation to the gathering. English association Secretary Mr. Chrisbin Saji delivered the vote of thanks.

The seminar sessions focused on two major themes: Print media, broadcast journalism and digital journalism. Participants were provided with comprehensive discussions and practical training in these areas. The objective was to equip the students with the necessary skills and knowledge to excel in the creation of newspapers as well as digital media content. The first section was about an introduction to journalism handled by Mr. Kishore Thomas (Journalist in 24 News Channel). Next session was about newspaper production. The topic was handled by Mr. Ghees Peter - Subeditor of 24 News Channel. After those sessions, Ms. Anjali

Raj AV (Subeditor in Brave India News) handled the session of digital journalism. The Practical session of "visual news production" was during the time of 3.00 pm to 6.00 pm. In that session students were divided in to 5 groups. Through this, students become more aware of the term voice over, piece to camera, anchor portion etc. also students worked on newspaper production and had supper. This was followed by cultural programme of the students and the chief guest for the cultural night was musician Ms. Elizabeth S Mathew. Through her delightful presence and her songs, the night got more colorful. The event lasted until 12.00 am.

The second day started with newspaper production. After breakfast, workshop began at 10.00 am. Students released their newspaper and news bulletin. The programme ended at 1.00 pm, with student's evaluation and certificate distribution.

The print media and digital journalism theme emphasized the importance of effective journalism in today's society. Participants gained insights into the editorial process, news writing techniques, and the ethical considerations that should be upheld by journalists in their reporting. The event was a great success.

DEBATE COMPETITION





Literature Quiz on Shakespeare



As the part of Association Day celebration of July month, the PG Department of English and INKJOURN club had conducted a literature quiz on the ever favourite topic of literature students, "Shakespeare," on 31/07/2023, at 2 pm. The objective of this quiz competition was to enhance eagerness to know more about this "Bard of Avon," who is widely regarded as one of the greatest writers in the English language.

It was an inter class competition held for students of II BA English, III BA English and II MA English. Total seven teams participated, two teams from II and III BA, and three groups from III MA. Quiz Mistress, Ms. Neethu Thankachan, conducted the quiz in a very interactive way and the teams participated with great enthusiasm. There were a total number of 5 rounds in the competition, which included rounds with and without options, two task rounds, and a rapid fire session. The students displayed ecstatic spirit and enjoyed the quiz to the fullest. The top three groups were declared as the first, second and the third winners of the competition. With 63 points, the team of Alan Lee Joseph and Merin Varghese (II MA), won the first prize. The

team of Rahil Ramesh and Navya Suresh of II MA secured second prize, scoring 50 marks. The third prize was secured by the team of Najiya MK and Sujata Sarkkar from III BA. The quiz ended at 3.15 pm, after the declaration of the winners with a great amount of applause.

Quiz was very informative and knowledge enriching for the participants as well as for the audience. It was a very successful event which fueled by the active participation of the teams and support of the audience as well.
