Article I: Name and Purpose

3.1 Executive Committee:

3.2 Term of Office:

The term of office of the Executive Committee shall be one year (calendar year).

3.3 Powers and Responsibilities of the Executive Committee:

Periodically review records and accounts.

Article IV: Activities

4.1 Regular Activities:

Heritage Tours: Organize heritage tours to historical and cultural sites.

Association with GOVT programmes; The club shall associate with the programmes and directions of the government tourism department.
