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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Planning Committee, a newly formed committee made on the instruction of the governing council of the Navajyothi College, has been convened to prepare a strategic plan for the forthcoming years of **Navajyothi College.** Following the instruction of the management of the college, IQAC Cell was formed in June 2016. A unanimous decision was taken to make a strategic plan for the future activities of the college. This body is intended to evaluate and assess the current status of the college and seek ways and means to improve the academic and non-academic performance of the students. It was also resolved to get the college accredited by NAC with an excellent grade. The Management and College were fully aware of the strenuous task required for achieving the goal.

As part of the execution of the proposed plan, the Committee has devised a plan at two levels: short term and long term. The Committee identified core areas of implementation, namely **empower**, **excellence**, **and change** which are modeled on the core values of the institution. 1. STRATEGIC PLAN: VISION AND OVERVIEW

PART 1

The Present Scenario

1.1 Navajyothi College: Status Quo

Navajyothi College, Cherupuzha in Kannur district is an academic initiative of the CST fathers of the Little Flower Congregation, who began their ministry there in the 1990s. They realised the desire of the people for a higher education, and hence an affiliated self-financing college was started in 2010. The first batch of students was admitted to the: three courses B.com (Computer Application), BBA, and BCA in the following year. In 2013 B.Com (Co-operation), BA English Literature with Journalism, and M.Com finance were added to the courses offered by the college.

From the beginning, the students of Navajyothi College were guided and motivated to excel both in academics and co-curricular activities. The College bagged university ranks in various courses since the completion of the course by the first batch of students. The management focuses on the training given the students both in curricular and co-curricular activities. The students of this college bagged many medals in sports and games at university level competitions. The departments conduct national and state-level fests and special events co-ordinating different campuses from across India. Department clubs and associations are very active on the campus giving a proper orientation to the students to become responsible citizens and charismatic leaders. The Management, staff and students work together to make a better, more prosperous and promising future for the posterity and the country.

2.2 Academic Goals

1. Accreditation by NAAC in 2021

One of the main objectives of the strategic plan is to achieve accreditation by NAAC. The five-year process leading to NAAC visit is to be carried out by systematic procedures in academic and co-academic activities. The establishment of IQAC is the first step in this process. The functions of each department, both in academics and co-academic, shall be synchronized by the IQAC cell of the college.

2. Increase Employability Skill among the Students by 2021

The college is situated in a village where not much exposure to training and other facilities is available. Hence the younger generation is still unaware of many of the opportunities available in the job market, both in Government and private sector. Training the young generation to enhance the employability skill among them shall be carried out as the duty and social commitment of the college. The infrastructure of the college shall be used for the same. By 2021 the college should be able to place as many students both in the Government and the private sector to change the quality of social lives of the young generation.

3. Provide Maximum exposure via add on courses and certificate courses

One of the finest ways of increasing employability skills among the students is to provide them with quality education. This is the avowed task of the college for the next five years. Each department shall be able to provide basic certificate course more than once in an academic year so as to enrich the academic lives and quality of the students. Apart from the certificate courses, the college provides add on courses of international recognition for the academic and industrial exposure of the students.

4. Infrastructure development

A college is evaluated by the infrastructure facilities available on the campus. The completion of the B block is to be done at the earliest so that each department can function more independently and effectively.

5. Reach out to the local community via outreach programmes.

There is always a question that remains to be asked at the end of the day on what has been done to the society by way of education. This institution shall be responsible for the manifold development of the society around it. Being situated in a backward area of the state, the College

tries to reach out to the people in the local area by offering quality education and thereby uplifting the morale and lifestyle of the people. By way of training the women and children in various sections, the College can be an instrument in the development of the society.

6. Impart training in competitive and eligibility examinations

While being trained in formal education, the stakeholders are also to be trained to excel in competitive and eligibility examinations conducted at the national and state level. The students of this college are from the middle class and lower-middle-class families; they might be financially unsound to attend excellent training centers of their choice. Therefore, the institution has taken its mission to provide quality training for the students to achieve their dream of getting professionally settled.

Navajyothi College is renowned for its diversity in its functioning. Being a self-financing college situated in a village in the north Malabar region, it has to be adaptive to the cultural background of its premises. People of this hilly area are mostly migrated from the south of Kerala, mainly Kottayam. Those migrated people toiled in the land to make a life for themselves and their descendants. By the first few decades of the 20st century, many were able to afford primary and secondary education to their wards. Unfortunately, higher education institutions were significantly inadequate to the aspiring children seeking tertiary level education. For a long time, this need was fulfilled by parallel education. This was the situation when the Little Flower Congregation started a college under self-finance scheme approved by the Government of Kerala and affiliated to Kannur University in 2010. From its very inception, the college has been determined to provide quality education to its aspiring students. The first intake of the students was in 2011. And after five years of its existence in the higher education field, we have identified the strength, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges of the college. It is learned after the analysis of all the aspects that the implementation of the strategic plan for 2021 will lift the college up to a competent institution among the higher educational institutions in Kerala.
